School Boundary Review Process - An Overview

What is a School Boundary Review Process?

- A process to create and/or alter school attendance area that define the service areas of a school.
- Creation of school attendance areas/boundaries are based on a Criteria approach, which are as follows:
 1. Optimizing the use of existing school facilities;
 2. Minimizing the use of portable classrooms whenever possible;
 3. To the extent possible, minimize school boundary adjustments over the long-term;
 4. Optimize school transportation and maximizing walkers to school;
 5. Ensure that classroom organizations are sustainably sized; and,
 6. Give due consideration to the concept of a neighbourhood and Catholic School community.

School Boundary Review Process - An Overview

Why is a School Boundary Review Needed in Milton?

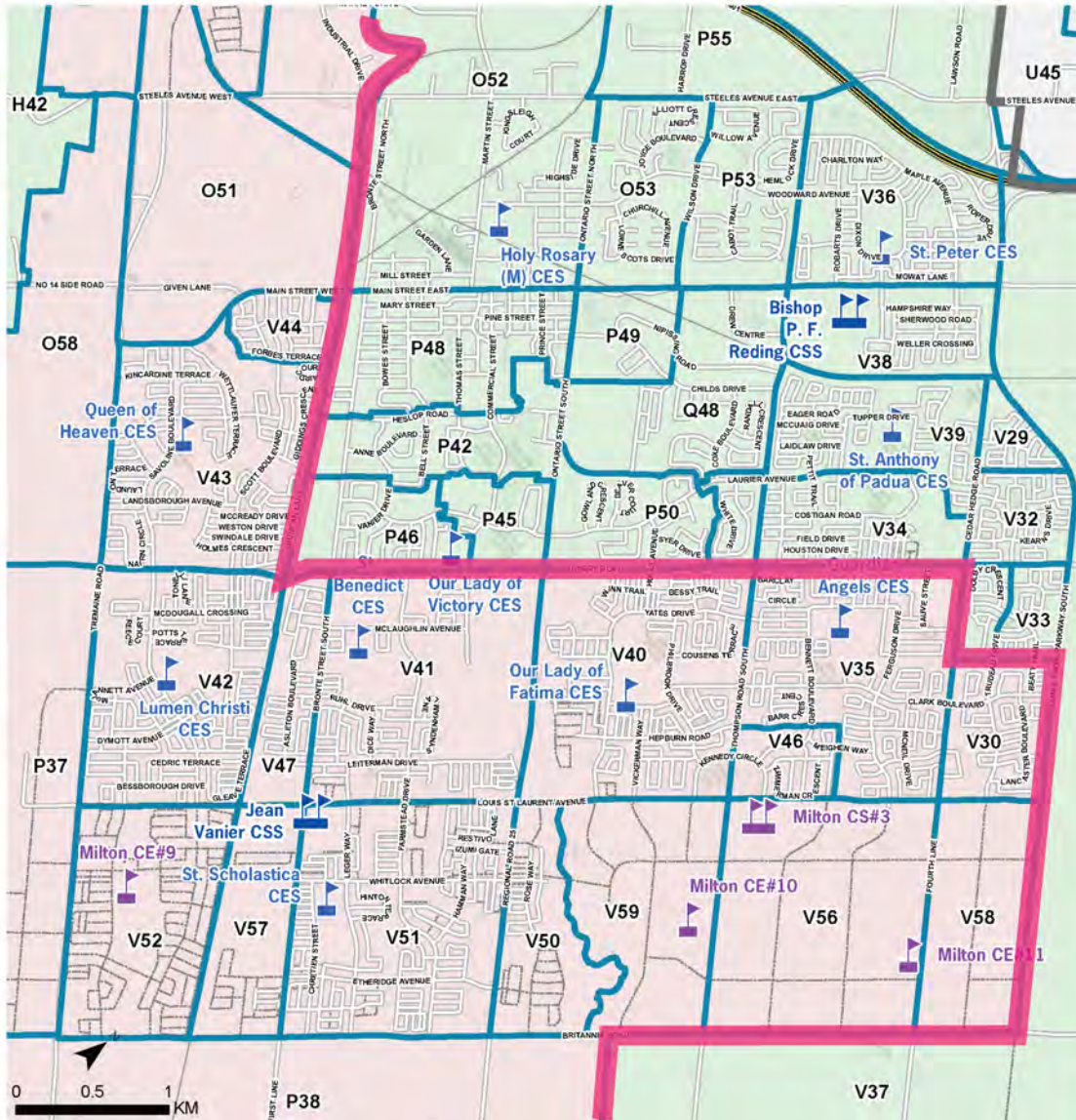
- Both secondary schools in Milton are FULL, requiring a new secondary school.
- There is inadequate space in existing secondary schools in the Town of Milton at present to accommodate growth in wait for the new Milton #3 CSS to open in 2022
- Staff expects a response from the Ministry in spring 2020, confirming project funding
- A School Boundary Review Process is needed to:
 1. Create an interim school boundary solution to accommodate Secondary Students Accommodation in Milton for the 2021 school year until Milton #3 CSS opens
 2. Create the final school boundary for the future Milton #3 CSS school community

School Boundary Review Process - An Overview

Who Participates in the Process?

- A School Boundary Review Committee (SBRC) involves the following members:
 1. Catholic School Council Chairs (or designates) of the affected school communities;
 2. Designated Family of Schools Superintendent as Chair, and a Co-chair if necessary; and,
 3. Facility Management Services and Planning Services Staff.
- The task of the SBRC is to review potential options and provide objective feedback.
- Once preferred options are identified by the Committee, they are presented to the affected school communities (the public) to gather feedback.
- Once a preferred recommended option is selected, Senior Staff will present the recommended accommodation to Trustees for consideration and approval.



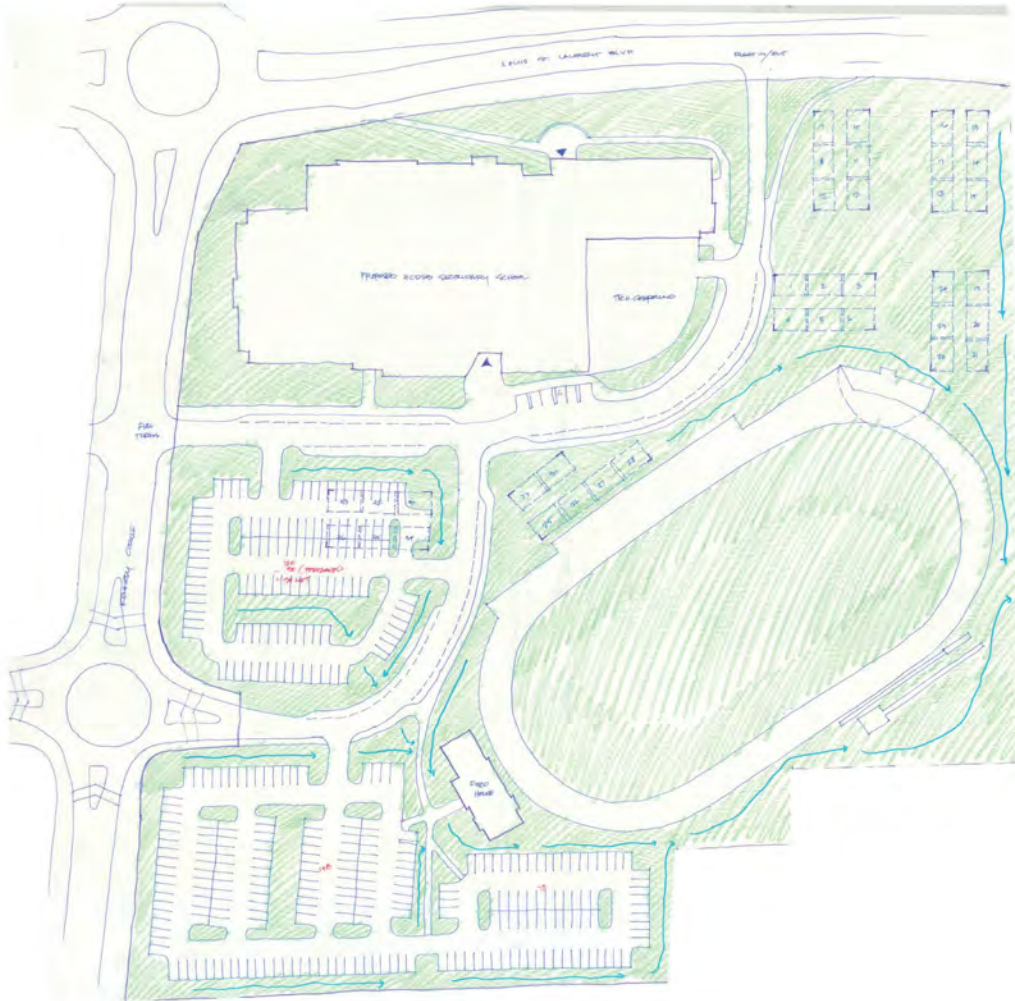

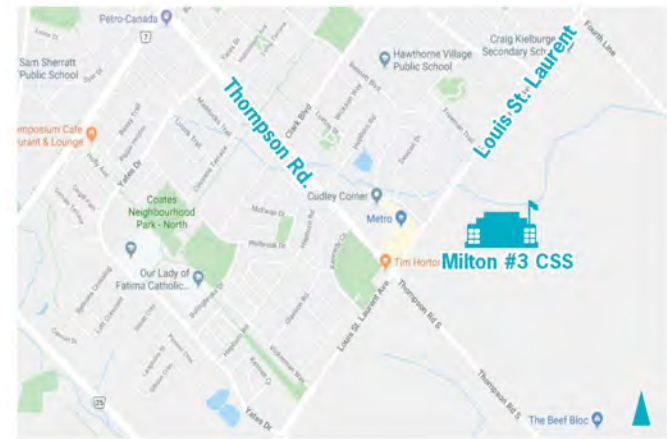
Site Plan Concept

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Milton Catholic Secondary School Boundary Review

Background

On September 30, 2019, the Board submitted its 2019-20 Capital Priorities Submission to the Ministry of Education. The Milton #3 Catholic Secondary School (CSS) project was submitted as Priority #1. It is anticipated the funding announcements will be made in early 2020, at which point the Board will receive confirmation if it was successful.

The 2019 [Long-Term Capital Plan Update](#) indicates that due to Jean Vanier CSS reaching its maximum portable capacity by the 2021-22 school year, the Milton #3 CSS project is required by the same school year. However, seeing as a secondary school takes a minimum of three years to construct, a 2021-22 opening date is not feasible. This may result in Milton #3 CSS students having to be temporarily relocated to alternate school accommodations with available space within the Board's jurisdiction.

As a response to the above concerns, the Board initiated a Secondary School Boundary Review for the Town of Milton secondary panel at the November 26, 2019 Special Board Meeting. Read the full report: [Milton Secondary School Boundary Review Action Report – November 26, 2019](#)
